Goal 1: Mentored 290 kids through the program/team.

We also added 17 kids to the Elite Eagles and rewarded them with \$1000 college scholarships. Another great moment of the year was our "essay contest". We staged an essay contest for all the kids in our program that did not have a computer at home. I say staged because we only pretended it was a contest. In actuality, every child that wrote an essay was given a computer.
