



The mission of the Durham Rescue Mission is to meet, through the power of Jesus Christ, the needs of the whole person - spiritual, educational, emotional, physical, vocational, and social - so that those who are hurting may become fully functioning members of society.

Goal: 38% of all male residents are enrolled in Victory Program

DRM Commentary: Currently we are 4% above our goal and **42% of all male residents are enrolled in Victory program.** A study tracking the last 3 years of graduates showed that 82% of those who complete this one year program have remained drug free and are functioning members in society. In a recent study of organizations who provide assistance to the homeless, the results showed that of the nine organizations the DRM houses 42% of the homeless population in Durham. We are continuing to strive in our overall mission, that everyone in the Triangle has a home, on earth and in Heaven.

Goal: Return \$1.75 of Value to the community for every \$1.00 donated

DRM Commentary: We are currently **\$0.26 below our goal.** We had lower than expected numbers at our last community event. This number should rise as we head in to the summer segment and our largest event, *Back to School*.

Goal: 34% of male Phase 1 Victory students complete class

DRM Commentary: Currently **33% of male Phase 1 Victory students have completed the class.** This statistic does not show a full 12 months of data. The Lord is continuing to work in all of those who entered into the program. We will continue to pray for each student that they follow the will of God.

Goal: 82% of male Phase 2 Victory students complete class

DRM Commentary: We did not have any new students enter the 2nd phase of the program during the 3rd quarter of last year. Again, this statistic is not fully meaningful until we have 12 months of data.

Goal: 96% of male Victory graduates are employed

DRM Commentary: Currently **100% of male Victory graduates are employed.** 100% of all our residents are working in some capacity everyday. We are striving to have all Victory graduates in a full time position by their completion date.
