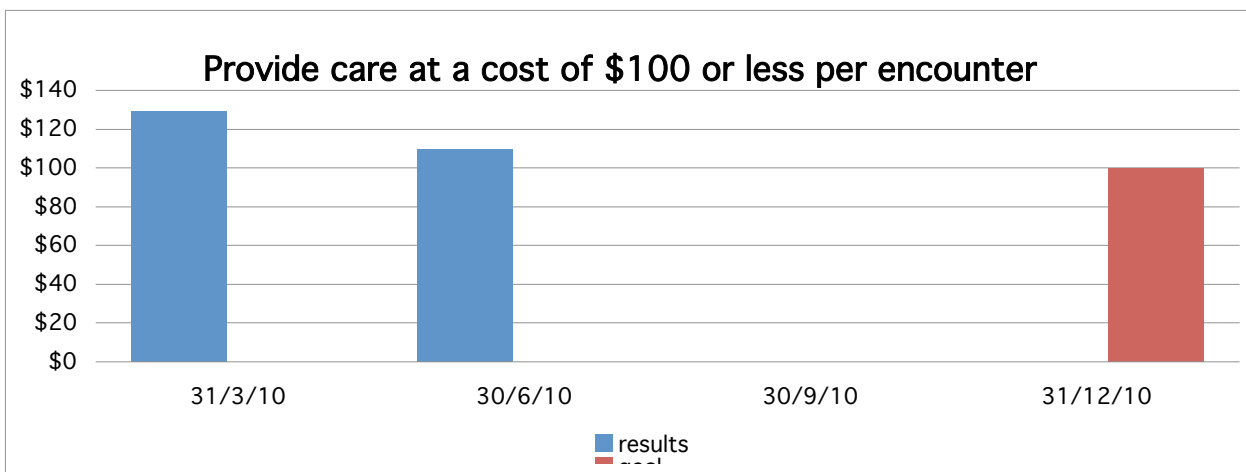
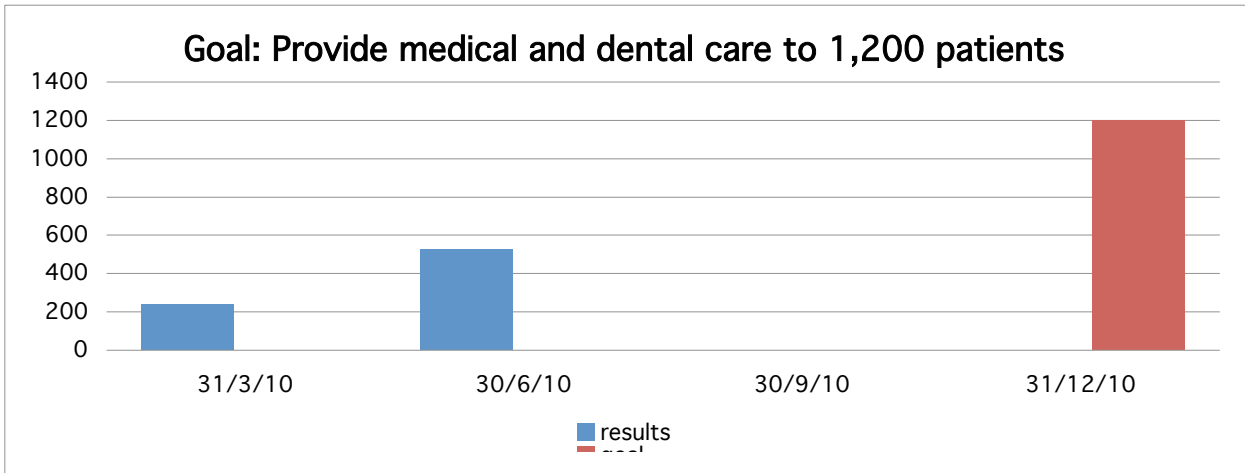


The SHC was formed to provide medical and dental care to the residents of the Durham Rescue Mission and Good Samaritan Inn, partner shelters housing over 700 homeless men, women, and children each year. They are a group of medical professionals and other volunteers who are bringing together the resources of area churches to meet the health care needs of the homeless in the name of Jesus Christ.



SHC Commentary: We are pleased that due to a renewed focus on volunteer recruitment, we had more capacity to see patients this quarter. Our medical, dental and eye patient visits were up across the board from Q1. This has resulted in our cost per patient to drop to \$110 per encounter, which is still a quarter of what a for-profit clinic would cost. With the addition of a new part-time volunteer Medical Director, we anticipate we will be able to reach our goal of 1,200 patient encounters by year end. We are grateful for the hard work of our volunteers which has made this strong progress possible.
